Start time	Display: Saturday star time will be displayed on Friday evening when bibs are collected. Sunday start time will be displayed on Saturday evening.	
	Stickers with Saturday's schedule will be given out at race number pick-up. Stickers with Sunday's start times will be distributed Sunday morning.	

Start times must be respected on Saturday and Sunday. Racers who are late will be penalized. They must try to make up for lost time on subsequent special stages.

PLATE COLLECTION

Plate collection	location	Salle polyvalente Vallandry - L'Eterlou cinema bulding
	schedule	Friday 11 July, from 18:30 to 22:00
	To collect your plate, you need : <ul style="list-style-type: none">- present your UCI 2025 license (with medical certificate mentioned) or a certificate of no contraindication to the practice of competitive mountain biking. No other license will be accepted.- DO NOT bring your bike to the bib collection point. The marking stickers will be affixed by the rider (diagram below)- No deposit required for transponders. 100 euros will be charged for any transponder not returned.- parental authorization for minors. ATTENTION: safety pins NOT provided	

Bike marking	Marking mountain bikes is mandatory and will be done by the rider directly on the bike (see regulations).
	The stickers must be affixed to the right side of the bike, on the fork, frame, rear arm (one sticker only) and wheels (on the wheel rim) + battery for e-MTBs. An additional sticker must be affixed to the second battery for elite e-MTBs and to the battery extender for open e-MTBs if they wish to use it.

TIMING SYSTEM

System used	Chip
Recovery location	To be collected when collecting your bibs and returned after the last special.
Use	The transponder is to be fixed using a plastic collar on the right fork sheath.
	The transponder must be in place on Saturday and Sunday.
Deposit	No deposit is required. If the transponder is not returned or is damaged, the runner will have to pay 100 euros.

EQUIPEMENT RULES

It is forbidden to wear a second helmet throughout the course

Stage	Mandatory: full face helmet (CE) in the fastened position, long gloves, knee pads, back protector (CE) or backpack with CE-approved back protector
	Recommended: elbow pads
Liaison	Mandatory: full face helmet (CE), in the attached position.
	Recommended: long gloves, knee pads, back protector (CE) or backpack with CE-approved back protector and elbow pads

Insurance	The organizer takes out civil liability insurance with the insurer of the French Cycling Federation: Gras Savoye. For non-licensed participants, it takes out individual accident insurance (conditions to be requested from the organizer)
